Please read this edition of our newsletter detailing some of the main points of learning in the coming weeks.

LITERACY AND ENGLISH

- In Creative Writing we shall focus on Imaginative Writing – Suspense Stories and Functional Writing – Persuasive Writing, using Talk for Writing.
- In Handwriting, we are continuing to develop skills in joined writing and presentation of work.
- We are continuing to use Active Spelling Strategies to revise/learn new spelling patterns.
- Extending our knowledge of Grammar through Talk for Writing activities.
- We are developing our Higher Order Reading skills and comprehension through our Class Novels/Non-Fiction Reading/ Library/Reading for Enjoyment:
- Developing listening/talking/presentation skills through class discussions and collaborative work linked to Enquiry-based Learning and IDL Topic

Helpful hints to support learning at home

- Read and discuss books. Encourage a love of reading for enjoyment.
- Practise spelling words in a fun way e.g. rainbow writing/pyramid writing
- Encourage your child to write at home and read what they write.
- Also, practise handwriting together.
- Encourage your child in conversations to listen and respond appropriately.
