LITERACY AND ENGLISH

- P3: Recognising, writing, counting and ordering numbers to 1000. Addition and subtraction of up to 3-digit numbers.
- P4: Recognising, writing, counting and ordering numbers to 10000. Addition and subtraction of up to 4-digit numbers.
- P5: Recognising, writing, counting and ordering numbers to 100000. Addition and subtraction of up to 4-digit numbers.

Whole Class: Recognising and describe the properties of 2D shapes and 3D objects

- Play number counting and ordering games.
- Look for 2D/3D shapes at home and in the environment.
